

Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Young Fellows Chapter Principles and Guidelines

- 1. Young Fellows Chapter (YFC) members should refer to its Terms of Reference as the basis for this establishment and development.
- 2. The Academy's statutory functions and objects should always be observed. The YFC is therefore expected to remain politically neutral in social or other matters.
- 3. Member should behave properly in the participation of YFC business. Any acts that may damage the reputation of Academy should be avoided.
- 4. Members should always uphold and respect any consensus decisions made by the governing council.
- 5. Members should not express opinions to the public on behalf of the Academy without prior authorization.
- 6. Members should make declaration of interests as early as possible whenever potential, perceived or actual conflicts of interest are encountered.
- 7. In cases of disputes or other issues requiring escalation, advice from the Academy Council should be sought in a timely manner.
- 8. Advice and consent from the Academy Council should be sought as required and whenever there are issues potentially leading to deviations from the above principles.
