Proposed essential changes in forthcoming CME/CPD cycles:

- The definition of CME would be gradually expanded and made comparable to CPD in broad terms.
- Starting from 1 January 2008, all Colleges would cap the passive CME points allowed at 75 points or below per cycle. Fellows would have to include some other CME/CPD activities into their CME/CPD cycle.
- Starting from 1 January 2011 tentatively,
 - Fellows must obtain some points in activities like quality assurance, medical audits, mortality and morbidity meetings, or those activities involving improvement of patient care;
 - contents will be expanded to cover other non-medical professional development activities such as knowledge and skills relating to relevant laws, information technology, clinic management and interpersonal communication.
