Topics and Speakers

Topic 1: Advances in AV Technology for Simulation



Dr. Jacky Chan, RN(Training Coordinator), A&E Training Centre, TSKH; Certified AV System Engineer

Dr Jacky Chan is an emergency nurse. He completed the Doctor of Nursing at The University of Hong Kong and Master of Prehospital and Emergency Care at The Chinese University of Hong Kong. His research focuses on the debriefing, technical issue and management in the healthcare simulation. He has 10 full paper and abstract published in international peer reviewed medical journals and has edited 2 first aid / trauma textbooks.

Jacky is the Nurse Coordinator of Accident & Emergency Training Centre, Hospital Authority Hong Kong. He has led different teaching teams to design and integrate simulation into clinical training for different specialties doctors and nurses, paramedics, and special units in the Hong Kong Police Force.

In addition, He is also a certified AV system engineer, he was seconded to the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine, the Hong Kong Children Hospital, to support the simulation centre design, construction, AV system and manikin connection design. His setup design included neonatal, pediatric, obstetric, adult (ACLS), ICU (ECMO sim), trauma, escort, disaster and tactical medicine simulation.

Topic 2: Improving Realism with Moulage



Dr Benny Cheng, Consultant, Department of Anaesthesia & Intensive Care, TMH/POH, NTWC

Benny is a consultant anaesthesiologist in Tuen Mun Hospital and Pok Oi Hospital. He has been the chair of Crew Resource Management (CRM) since it was first initiated in New Territories West Cluster. Benny is the director of various courses organized by the Clinical Simulation Committee under the Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists, namely Air Crew Resuscitation Simulation (ACRS) Course for the Hong Kong Government Flying Service and Management of Anaesthetic Critical Events (MACE) Course. He is a credential simulation debriefer and he is an active instructor of various simulation courses. Spurred on by a passion for safety culture, Benny and his team are dedicated to team training. Building on over fifteen years of experience in course development and simulation, Benny has successfully immersed CRM in simulation-based training, which facilitates self-reflection among participants and serves as a powerful tool in adult learning model. Benny devotes his time to CRM propagation and quality improvement. He is on the CRM Training Materials and Guidelines Editorial Board and he is a member of Team-Based Simulation Quality and Standards Group. He has led CRM to workplaces via the introduction of in-situ simulation.




Dr Carmen Lam, Associate Consultant, Department of Anaesthesia & Intensive Care, TMH, NTWC
