

Croucher Scholarships and Fellowships 2014

Applications are invited for study awards tenable in 2014. If you are a permanent Hong Kong resident and wish to pursue a career in the natural sciences, technology or medicine then you may be eligible for one of these competitive awards.

Croucher Fellowships for postdoctoral research

For promising young researchers who obtained doctoral degrees after September 2012, students in the final year of their doctoral studies, or qualified medical doctors.

- Tenable at institutions outside Hong Kong.
- Full cost award covering airfares, a contribution towards living expenses, a conference grant and other allowances over a period of up to two years.
- Candidates must prepare a detailed research proposal.

Croucher Scholarships for full time doctoral studies

For outstanding students with First Class Honours or equivalent degrees, final year undergraduate students, or MPhil students graduating before September 2014.

- Tenable at institutions outside Hong Kong.
- Full cost award including tuition fees, airfares, a contribution towards living expenses, a conference grant and other allowances over a period of up to and including the third year of study.
- Offers to final year undergraduate students conditional upon candidates obtaining First Class Honours or equivalent.
- Candidates must prepare a detailed research proposal.

Through partnership agreements with the Universities of Cambridge and Oxford, and institutions in France and Germany, the Foundation offers a number of special scholarships for doctoral study. Please refer to our web site for details of these awards.
