Dr Julian STERN trained in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy at the Maudsley Hospital, and at the Lincoln Centre, now part of the BPF (British Psychotherapy Federation). For 17 years he headed the unique Psychological Medicine unit at St Mark's Hospital, Harrow, a hospital for patients with gastrointestinal disorders, before moving to the Tavistock Centre in 2010, where he has worked as Consultant Psychiatrist in Psychotherapy. In 2016 he was appointed director of Adult and Forensic services in the Trust. He has a special interest in patients with Medical symptoms and disorders. He has published widely, in medical, psychotherapy and psychiatry journals and is co-editor of the popular textbook "Core Psychiatry".
