Government Flying Service (GFS) is one of the disciplinary forces safeguarding Hong Kong round the clock. In 2000, Auxiliary Medical Unit was commenced with the motto "Bring A&E to the patient", and now there are around 30 flying doctors from various specialties and also emergency nurses providing voluntary medical services.
