- Judging Panel and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the Competition.

#### Submission requirements and guidelines

- $\bigcirc$ Each entrant may submit up to two (2) entries but no entrant may win more than one prize.
- Photographs can be taken with digital camera or mobile phone.
- All entries must be no smaller than 2MB and no larger than 5MB each. Files should be in RGB jpeg format.
- Only entries submitted online will be eligible and no printed or film submissions will be accepted.
- A submission must be an original photograph taken and owned by the entrant, and has not been sold, published or entered in other competitions.

The entry period starts from 0900hrs, 15 August 2021 to 1700hrs, 30 October 2021 (Hong Kong standard time)



#### Selection and judging criteria

Prizes will be decided by the Judging Panel consisting of professional photographer(s), Academy Officers and Secretariat. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- $\bigcirc$ Communication of the theme - relevancy, denotation and vividness of message (30%)
- Creativity and innovation  $\Diamond$ - Choice of elements and uniqueness (25%)
- Technical merit  $\bigcirc$ - Skills of photography (25%)
- Visual impact and aesthetic sense  $\bigcirc$ - Photographic vision (20%)

Each entrant may submit up to two (2) entries in RGB jpeg format (each be at least 2MB but not exceed 5MB in size) but no entrant may win more than one prize.

Each entry does not contain personally identifiable information.

Only entries submitted online will be eligible and no printed or film submissions will be accepted.

Submissions must be received before the closing deadline of 1700hrs, 30 October 2021 (Hong Kong standard time).

By entering the Competition, each entrant:

- confirms that his / her entries are their wholly owned creation. The entry must not have been sold, published or entered in other competitions.
- warrants that his / her entries do not infringe any copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity.
- In the right to the Academy to retain the entries and edit, use or exhibit them on any publicity materials, means and events for any purpose. Prior consent from the entrants is not required and no copyright royalty shall be paid to the entrants.
- $\diamond$  consents to the use of their personal data by the Academy for the administration of the Competition.

Entries for different prize categories will be selected as per the judging criteria. The results will be announced on the Academy website in November 2021.
