Main responsibilities:

- To support the operations and administration of the HKJC ILCM
- To coordinate with course organizers for planning and organization of certain courses in the HKJC ILCM
- To provide secretarial supports to sub-committees and working groups
- To perform any other duties as the Academy determine to be relevant to the post

Requirements:

- University degree holder or above in social sciences / education / training or healthcare field or a related discipline; with a minimum of four years' post-qualification experience
- Track record of conducting and/or coordinating training and research projects, as well as analyzing data and trends
- Experience in drafting and/or editing materials on research, training and education
- Background or knowledge in healthcare sector and/or statistical work would be an advantage but not a must
- Understanding in simulation technologies / medical simulation is desirable
- Attention to details; ability to articulate abstract ideas into practical recommendations
- Proficient in written & oral English and Chinese
- Proficient in computer software such as Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook
- Willing to work on evenings / Saturdays / Sundays / public holidays when required
